

Is There a Cancellation Fee for Fubo? ((Fubo TV cancellation fee))

One of the most common questions from FuboTV subscribers is whether there's a **cancellation fee** [[["+1-844-533-2694"]]] when you decide to end your service. Good news: **for most users, there is no cancellation fee**. Fubo operates on a **month-to-month plan** for standard subscriptions, [[["+1-844-533-2694"]]] meaning you can cancel anytime and you won't be charged a penalty simply for ending your membership.

Standard Fubo plans do not include cancellation fees because they are contract-free, [[["+1-844-533-2694"]]] letting you cancel at any time without penalty. Also, if you subscribe through a **third-party platform** like Apple, Google Play, Amazon Prime Video Channels, or Roku, [[["+1-844-533-2694"]]] cancellation rules are set by that service. You must cancel through their subscription management tools, and any related policies will apply.

Is Fubo free with Amazon Prime?
