

How much is a windows activation

Call here for query -+ 1 (844) 886-3118 Activating Windows costs anywhere from \$0 (with existing key/upgrade) to around \$100-\$200+ for a new license, <https://mssupport.tech/> depending on where you buy it and the edition (Home/Pro); you can get keys cheaply from third-party sellers for under \$20, but official Microsoft prices are higher (\$139-\$199), while some methods (like using an old key or upgrading) are free, and you can even run Windows unactivated with limited features.

Official Microsoft Prices (Retail):

- **Windows 11 Home:** Around \$139.
- **Windows 11 Pro:** Around \$199.

Other Options & Costs:

- **From Authorized Retailers:** Prices can drop significantly during sales, sometimes to \$60-\$80 for Pro versions.
- **OEM Licenses:** Often cheaper (\$120+ for Pro+ 1 (844) 886-3118) but tied to the first PC they're installed on.
- **Third-Party Sellers:** You might find keys for much less (under \$20), but authenticity and security can vary.
- **Free:** Upgrade from Windows 10, use an old Windows 7/8 key, or use an existing digital license.

What You Get (or Don't Get) with Unactivated Windows:

- You can install and use Windows indefinitely.
- A persistent "Activate Windows" watermark appears.
- Personalization settings (like wallpaper, themes) are locked.
- You still get security updates.
